

Robert E. “Bob” Moser

1917 - 2016



Robert E. Moser “Bob” was born on September 23, 1917 in August, KS to Edward and Lillie (Boucher) Moser. Bob and Charleen Moser were married in 1939, and raised four daughters.

Mr. Moser began his work as a Land Surveyor in 1938. After serving in the U.S. Navy, he began his career as an oifield surveyor’s rodman with Laughlin-Simmons. In 1940, he was promoted and worked as a draftsman and surveyor-at-large. Mr. Moser worked in the mid-continent region where elevations of wells varied from sea level in the Gulf of Mexico to 10,000 feet in the Rocky Mountains. After WWII, Mr. Moser was assigned the entire state of Kansas. During his 75 year career, he surveyed over 100,000 wells and drove over 2,000,000 miles. He served as President of the Kansas Society of Land Surveyors and as a delegate to the American Congress Surveying & Mapping in Washington, D.C.
