

## Arthur James Jim Robinson 1924 – 2013



Mr. Robinson, referred to as Jim, moved from Pennsylvania to Oklahoma with his family when he was eleven years old. His father was Vice President of Forest Oil Corporation. As a young man, he worked in the oilfields as a field hand and roustabout. After serving in the Army Air Corps, he began his oil career supervising field operations in Kansas, Oklahoma and Texas.

In 1965, Mr. Robinson became co-owner of Chief Drilling Company. In 1978, he founded and was President of Double Eagle Exploration. From 1991-1994, Mr. Robinson was appointed by Governor Finney to serve as Chairman & commissioner of Kansas Corporation Commission and Kansas Oil and Gas Advisory Committee.

Mr. Robinson had many involvements. He was a former WSU Board of Trustees Chariman, Golden Gloves Boxing coach and referee, a member of the Great Bend Lodge No. 15, Kansas York Rite, Scottish Rite 32, and the Midian Shrine Temple.
