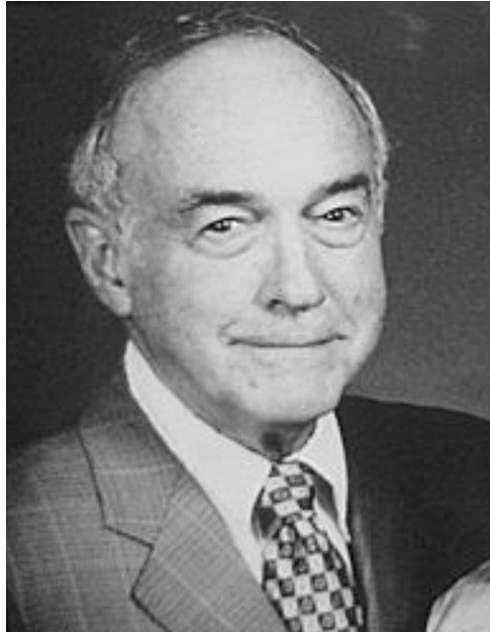


Jack Spines

1918 - 2003



Mr. Spines was a local businessman and grandson of Chester Latham, lawyer and oil operator in the 1900s. He attended WSU and graduated from K.U. Business School. He was a lieutenant in the U.S. Navy and served as a supply officer in WWII. Mr. Spines partnered with Bill Brunson and purchased Brinrich Drilling Company in 1953 and renamed it Brunson-Spines, Inc. in 1958. The company was involved in exploration, secondary recovery development and production. In 1989, Mr. Spines organized Spines exploration with his son, Tom.

Jack was President of Spines Clothing Co. and was a partner in Brunson-Spines Production Company. He was President of the Wichita Area Chamber of Commerce, a member and past President of the Downtown Rotary, was Director and past Chairman of the Midway Chapter of the American Red Cross. Jack was Director and member of the Executive Committee of Rainbows United, was Chairman of the Quivira Council Boy Scouts, past President of the Wichita Country Club and was a past member of the Board of Advisors for KU Business School. Jack was involved in Albert Pike Lodge, Wichita Consistory and Midian Shrine.
